PRGRSV CHARGES SAIGON WITH INTENSIFYING FIGHTING

Liberation Radio [Clandestine] in Vietnamese to South Vietnam 1000 GMT 7 Jul 73 S

[Text] At the 6 July 1973 session of the central Two-Party JMC, Col Vo Dong Giang firmly denounced and strongly condemned the Saigon administration for deliberately intensifying the fighting in many important areas placed under the PRGRSV's control. More serious, at noon on 2 July 1973, they sent many aircraft to drop scores of bombs and fire rockets at the Phuong Hoang airfield, in Dak To, Kontum Province, which is situated far inside the area under the PRGRSV's control. These air strikes took place just one day after Nguyen Van Thieu arrived in Kontum to boast about the war and to call on his troops to act against the cease-fire order.

Col Vo Dong Giang severely warned the Saigon administration that it must be held responsible for all serious consequences resulting from its deliberate acts of intensifying the fighting. Col Vo Dong Giang demanded that the Saigon administration:

- 1--Issue another order to its troops to strictly observe the cease-fire.
- 2--Order its troops in Kontum to immediately end all mopping-up and nibbling operations.
- 3--Together with the PRGRSV's military delegation to the Two-Party JMC send a JMC team to the areas where clashes are taking place in Kontum to help the commanders of the opposing forces meet and discuss temporary measures to put an end to the clashes.

Nevertheless the Saigon administration has tried by every possible means to evade discussing our proposals, to slander them, and to justify its acts of deliberately and seriously violating the cease-fire order.
