73.224 -- LYING: A NATIONAL POLICY OF U.S., SAYS NHAN DAN.

HANOI, VIETNAM, JULY 18 -- NHAN DAN IN A COMMENTARY TODAY CONDEMNED THE NIXON ADMINISTRATION'S COVER-UP OF U.S. BOMBING RAIDS IN CAMBODIA.

ANOTHER SECRET IN THE U.S. NATIONAL POLICY ON INDOCHINA HAS BEEN DISCLOSED, THE PAPER SAID, QUOTING A FORMER U.S. AIR FORCE MAJOR AS TESTIFYING THAT B52S HAD CONDUCTED SECRET BOMBING RAIDS OVER CAMBODIA SINCE EARLY 1970. THE PAPER ALSO QUOTED AN AIR FORCE SOURCE AS DISCLOSING THAT B.52S BOMBING RAIDS HAD BEEN CARRIED OUT IN SECRET RIGHT FROM THE SPRING OF 1969.

SO, THE PAPER SAID, THE TRUE NATURE OF THE U.S. AGGRESSORS IN CAMBODIA HAS BEEN LAID BARE. BUT THE U.S. AGGRESSIVE ACTS AGAINST CAMBODIA DID NOT (NOT) BEGIN IN 1969, NOT (NOT) EVEN IN EARLY 1970 WITH JUST A FEW DOZENS BOMBING RAIDS. ACCORDING TO THE CAMBODIAN ROYAL GOVERNMENT'S FIGURES, ONLY FROM EARLY 1962 TO 1969, 7,000 (SEVENTHOUSAND) ENCROACHMENTS UPON CAMBODIA'S AIR SPACE, WATERS AND TERRITORY WERE COMMITTED BY THE U.S. AND ITS CLIENT ADMINISTRATIONS IN SAIGON AND BANGKOK.

WHY HAS THE NIXON ADMINISTRATION TRIED TO COVER UP THE U.S. BOMBING IN CAMBODIA? FACTS SPEAK FOR THEMSELVES. TELLING LIES AND MAKING BLANDERS HAS BEEN A NATIONAL POLICY OF THIS ADMINISTRATION SINCE IT HAS FOUND NO (NO) BETTER WAY TO PLEAD FOR ITS AGGRESSIVE POLICY AND UNJUST WARS.

THE NIXON ADMINISTRATION'S LIES, NOW AS IN THE PAST, CONCERNING THE CAMBODIAN ISSUE HAS DONE GREAT PREJUDICE TO THE U.S. HONOUR. NO DOUBT, THE FRESH DISCLOSURE WILL STRENGTHEN THE DETERMINATION OF THE PEOPLE AND POLITICAL CIRCLES IN THE U.S. IN THEIR CURRENT CAMPAIGN TO DEMAND THAT THE NIXON ADMINISTRATION STOP FORTHWITH AND UNCONDITIONALLY ITS AGGRESSIVE WAR IN CAMBODIA, THE PAPER SAID IN CONCLUDING./.
