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FRONT RADIO CITES REPORTS ON U.S. VESSELS HEADING TO VIETNAM

Liberation Radio [Clandestine] in Vietnamese to South Vietnam 0518 GMT 8 Jan 75 SG

[Text] Along with sending the aircraft carrier Coral Sea to operate along the South Vietnamese coast, on 7 January the United States, according to a UPI dispatch, despatched a U.S. Naval task force composed of 11 vessels and led by the aircraft carrier Enterprise to the South Vietnamese coast.

This action by the Ford administration has been vigorously protested by U.S. public opinion. Therefore, according to an AP dispatch, the White House press secretary on 7 January denied that it was true that a U.S. naval task force was moving into South Vietnamese territorial waters. Meanwhile, the Pentagon said these vessels were directly heading southwestward, but refused to disclose their destination. Obviously, the U.S. administration is very embarrassed before public opinion because of its extremely brazen violations of the Paris agreement on Vietnam.

One must be very vigilant in the fact of the ambiguous statements by the Ford administration. Meanwhile, U.S. President Gerald Ford stated that he was closely following the situation in the south. All of this is proof of the actions and schemes of the U.S. authorities who are continuing to interfere in South Vietnamese affairs and to gravely sabotage the Paris agreement. Public opinion is following the U.S. actions and is condemning all the sinister maneuvers of the Ford administration.
