TASS CITES PROGRSV SPOKESMAN ON THIEU STATEMENT

[Text] Paris January 28 TASS--A spokesman for the delegation of the Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Vietnam at consultative meetings between the two South Vietnamese sides at La Celle-Saint-Cloud today made a statement concerning an interview by Nguyen Van Thieu which was distributed on Monday, the interview in which he said that if he gets from the United States enough armaments and military equipment, he is ready to wage the war in South Vietnam till the end.

These bellicose statements show again how well grounded are the demands of the overwhelming majority of the South Vietnamese population to remove the regime of Nguyen Van Thieu and to form in Saigon a new administration. This will make it possible to settle quickly internal problems of South Vietnam through resumption of talks between the two South Vietnamese sides, the statement says.

The statement stresses that the United States continues delivering weapons and munitions to South Vietnam so that its placemen in Saigon could continue with annihilation and destruction. "If the United States wishes to get out of the present impasse and to find a way out of the deteriorating situation in South Vietnam, it must give up all the military commitments and end all interference in internal affairs of South Vietnam", said the spokesman of the delegation of the Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Vietnam at conferences in La Celle-Saint-Cloud.
