[Excerpts] QUAN DOI NHAN DAN today carries a commentary entitled "The World Is Supporting Our People and Condemning the U.S.-Thieu Clique" which points out: During the stalwart struggle of the past 2 years to protect and implement the Paris agreement, our people in both north and south have received great support from fraternal socialist countries, friendly countries, and democratic peace forces the world over, including the American people. The world front in solidarity with Vietnam and support of our people in their struggle to implement the Paris agreement and to build the South Vietnam's liberated areas has expanded incessantly. More than 20 governments and over 100 national and international organizations have provided the PRG with nonrefundable aid.

The U.S. imperialists want to eliminate the Vietnam problem from international political life and to conceal their involvement and intervention in South Vietnam, but they have tragically failed. This is part of the struggle for independence, peace and security in Indochina and Southeast Asia and an inseparable part of the revolutionary struggle of the peoples of the world.
