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U.S. MILITARY INVOLVEMENT IN S. VIETNAM SCORED

DRV Foreign Ministry Statement

[Text] Hanoi February 10 TASS--The Foreign Ministry of the DRV has condemned U.S. military involvement in South Vietnam.

In its statement the DRV Foreign Ministry stresses that a few days ago a Pentagon spokesman officially recognized that a contingent of U.S. Air force officers was sent additionally to South Vietnam from Thailand, the Philippines and South Korea.

These actions by the United States are qualified by the DRV Foreign Ministry as an extremely serious violation of the Paris agreement on Vietnam which bans the dispatch of American military personnel and military materials to South Vietnam.

The Government of the DRV demanded an immediate end to such actions and stressed that the U.S. Government bears all the burden of responsibility for possible consequences of such actions, the statement of the DRV Foreign Ministry stresses.

The statement says that State Department and Pentagon officials admitted that the United States recently sent a group of air force officers to South Vietnam.

The Foreign Ministry of the RSV strongly condemns these American actions, the statement stresses.
