PRGRSV SPOKESMAN, MILITARY DELEGATION UPDATES CEASE-FIRE VIOLATIONS

1 Mar Foreign Ministry Spokesman Statement

Liberation Radio [Clandestine] in Vietnamese to South Vietnam 1000 GMT 1 Mar 5 BK

[Text] The PRGRSV Foreign Ministry spokesman on 1 March 1975 issued a statement saying that between 21 and 28 February 1975, the Nguyen Van Thieu administration committed 8,592 cease-fire violations, including 448 nibbling operations, 7,360 police and pacification operations, 396 artillery shellings and 388 armed air reconnaissance and bombing flights.

In total, between 28 January 1973 and 28 February 1975, the Nguyen Van Thieu administration has committed 585,378 violations, including 63,396 nibbling operations, 436,760 police and pacification operations, 51,695 artillery shellings and 33,527 armed air reconnaissance and bombing flights.

26 Feb Military Delegation Notes

Hanoi VMA in French 1210 GMT 1 Mar 75 BK

[Text] Hanoi VMA 1 March--The PRGRSV military delegation to the Two-Party JMC on 26 February sent two notes to the chairman of the ICCS denouncing the cease-fire violations committed by the Saigon administration in the liberated zone of the PRGRSV, LPA reported.

The two notes cited the 106 military operations conducted by the Saigon troops in Binh Tuy, Tay Ninh, Bien Hoa, Ba Ria, Vinh Long, Tra Vinh, Can Tho, Chuong Thien, Rach Gia, Ca Mau and Bac Lieu provinces between 4 and 18 February.
