JAPANESE WOMEN, CHILDREN ADVISED TO LEAVE VIETNAM

[Excerpt] Saigon April 3 KYODO--Japanese women and children living in South Vietnam were advised to evacuate the country by the Japanese Embassy here Thursday. Embassy officials said they wanted no repetition of the refugee panic seen in Danang and Hue, which fell to insurgent forces.

Some 215 Japanese women and children are now living in Saigon and 16 others elsewhere in the country, they added. All of them were advised to leave the country within a week, they said.
