DANANG POPULACE SEES REVOLUTIONARY FILM SHOW 30 MAR

[Text] Hanoi VNA April 4--Tens of thousands of people of various walks of life in Danang on the evening of March 30, one day after the complete liberation of the city, attended the first showing of revolutionary films at the municipal stadium, according to GIAI PHONG PRESS AGENCY (LPA).
