SAIGON CHARGED WITH INTERFERING IN PRG-DRV JMC ACTIVITIES

LPA From North Vietnam [Clandestine] in English to East Europe and the Far East

[Text] South Vietnam April 6 LPA--The Nguyen Van Thieu administration on the afternoon of April 4, 1975 prevented the military delegations of the Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Vietnam and of the Democratic Republic of Vietnam from attending a reception offered by the Hungarian delegation on the occasion of Hungary's 30th national day. The Thieu clique groundlessly refused to send liaison officers and military police to escort the delegations as usual. This is the fourth time within 3 days running that the Thieu administration hindered normal contacts of the military delegations of the PRG/RSV to the central Two-Party Joint Military Commission with the outside world. It should be recalled that since January 23, 1975 the Thieu administration has repeatedly undermined all Saigon-Loc Ninh regular liaison flights. On the morning of April 4, 1975, in collusion with the Thieu clique, the United States cancelled the Saigon-Hanoi regular flight.
