KISSINGER REMARKS PROVE U.S. INTERFERENCE IN VIETNAM

Liberation Radio [Clandestine] in Vietnamese to South Vietnam 0500 GMT 6 Apr 75 SG

[Text] According to Western sources, U.S. Secretary of State Kissinger stated at a press conference on 5 April that Ford will tell the U.S. Congress on 10 April what he wants the United States to do to help the puppet Thieu administration to survive in the face of the present offensive of the South Vietnamese troops and people.

Kissinger added that Thieu's present predicament has resulted from the reduction of U.S. aid to the Thieu administration over the past 2 years. He brazenly stated: Some military aid has been approved but has not been used. This aid, amounting to \$175 million, is being expedited to the puppet Thieu administration.

Through these statements of the U.S. secretary of state, people can see that the Ford administration is stubbornly adhering to the Nixon doctrine and continuing to foster the fascist, dictatorial and bellicose lackey Nguyen Van Thieu. The fact that the United States continues to give military aid to the puppet Nguyen Van Thieu administration to continue the war and wreck peace is a blatant violation of the provisions of the Paris agreement on Vietnam.

The Ford administration's military involvement and interference in South Vietnam's internal affairs is being strongly condemned by world public opinion and even by U.S. political circles. The Ford administration is now encountering strong protests by the U.S. people and Congress. Despite its efforts to give more aid to the puppet Nguyen Van Thieu administration, it cannot reverse Thieu's present collapsing situation.
