WEYAND STRESSES THIEU CLIQUE CANNOT SURVIVE WITHOUT AID

Hanoi in Vietnamese to Vietnam 2300 GMT 8 Apr 75 SG

[Text] According to UPI, testifying before the U.S. Senate Armed Services Committee on 8 April U.S. Army Chief of Staff, General Weyand, stated that the Thieu clique would not survive if it was not granted additional military aid.

Weyand was recently sent to South Vietnam to assess the Thieu clique's heavy setbacks.

UPI remarked: While the White House has spread the news that Ford is not paying attention to Weyand's proposal for additional military aid to the Thieu clique because he sees that Congress seems to strongly oppose his request, Ford used Weyand as a mouthpiece to speak for him.
