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IZVESTIYA CORRESPONDENT REPORTS FROM DANANG

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[Text] Moscow--The paper IZVESTIYA notes that the leaders of various religious communities in liberated Danang are giving their full confidence to the new organs of power. The IZVESTIYA correspondent writes in particular in his reportage from Danang, the second largest city in South Vietnam:

The archbishop of the Catholic Church, Nguyen Quang Xuyen, told me how on the night of March 27-28 the telephone rang in his apartment. It was the Saigon general commanding the zone of the First Corps demanding that he should be evacuated immediately to Saigon. The elderly archbishop refused to leave the city.

There are more than 10,000 Catholics in Danang, he said, and almost all of them have stayed in the city. The people's government has already proved to us their good relations with the faithful and we are seeing great and positive changes taking place these days in Danang, and are beginning to feel complete confidence in the new organs of power.

(Ho Tan Sin), the head of the Cao Dai community, which numbers no less than 12,000 persons in the city, feels that the withdrawal of the Saigon military has become a blessing for Danang. We believe, he stressed, that under the new power foreign occupiers will never enter our land. The future is for this power.
