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U.S. FAILURE TO AID RVN EMBOLDENS DPRK, PAK SAYS

[Text] Seoul, April 17 (HAPTONG)--President Pak Chong-hui warned that communization of Cambodia and South Vietnam would have a far-reaching implication for the future of South Korean security.

Speaking to a group of local leaders in his home province of North Kyongsang Wednesday, Pak said communization of Indochina might tempt North Korea to launch an armed attack on South Korea. He said the failure of the United States to come to the aid of Indochinese countries in the face of communist aggression has already emboldened North Korea.

Pak attached significance to the forthcoming visit by Kim Il-sung (North Korean president) to Peking. He recalled Kim traveled to Moscow and had talks with Soviet leaders shortly before North Korea launched the armed aggression back in 1950.

ROCKEFELLER REAFFIRMS U.S. COMMITMENTS TO ROK

[Text] Prime Minister Kim Chong-pil, after attending a funeral service this morning for the late ROC President Chiang Kai-shek, met with U.S. Vice President Rockefeller at the Grand Hotel in Taipei. They discussed the traditional friendship between the United States and Korea, the Southeast Asian situation and other matters of mutual concern.

At the 50-minute meeting, Vice President Rockefeller vowed that the United States will faithfully fulfill its defense commitment to the ROK under any circumstances, press secretary to the prime minister Chong In-yang said. Rockefeller confirmed that there would not be the slightest change in the firm attitude of the United States toward its assistance to the defense of the ROK, Chong added.

Prime Minister Kim met with Tran Van Lam, speaker of the South Vietnamese Senate, in the Grand Hotel and exchanged views on the latest developments in Vietnam and the Southeast Asian situation.

In the evening Kim attended a reception hosted by Chiang Ching-kuo, premier of the ROC administrative Yuan. At the reception, in honor of the foreign envoys visiting Taipei to express condolences on Chiang Kai-shek's death, Kim talked with representatives from other countries on matters of common concern.
