two letters (one from Dad & the
other a friend back at Centre) in
my box, but was glad to see some-
thing from home. - Oh, by the
way Mom, I received your letter
you mailed on the 19th of April.
I can honestly say that I
never expected that letters would
mean as much as they do now.
I'm written to everyone - so I should
be getting a group of mail this week.
- Then after picking up my mail
I ate slow & the proceeded over
to the gym to treat myself at.

Dad, you'd sure guess that the Squadron I'm in 1877 across Sq - in actuality is the telephone company on that - must run in the family - huh? There's going to break all the checks & receipts in the Squadron into key punch - something else to pass the time.
