Today is the halfway mark, only six months left to go.

I hope all is going well for all of you.

The reason I'm writing is because I've got something to write about. Yes, I'm still in the best of health and spirits. There's the real info - the squadron got a message down the other day requesting for myself and a few other people to go PCS in country (permanent change of station) to Tan Son Nhut AFS, located in Saigon - I'm sure you hear about it alot, it's a good big base, so the date is the 1st of November I have to be there, and I'll stay there until I leave the Nam. This means that I'll be flying into Davis AFB for discharge rather than W-Quins.

Yesterday I had to hard carry some material down to Saigon for the Commander. So the route I took was to start by waiting around to catch a chopper and our Vietnamese pack - which I waited at for

an hour and a half until an Army
chopper came in, then they chipped
me off at an Army fire base - Del
Main located rounds - and caught
another chopper to TSN, Saigon.
After clearing the goods I headed
down town to do some rally again.
Had a lot of fun, then headed
back here for the purpose of keeping
myself covered.
