There is always about a two week delay between letters. As I told another soldier, it is just like living with another person and only talking to him once every two weeks and then waiting two more weeks for an answer.

This morning I received a letter from you saying that you would send the "fishing line" as soon as possible. Two months ago I needed fishing line to set up beehives in the jungle. Now that I am on T Bone I don't need fishing line. There is always a time delay in letter writing from Vietnam.

If I were to ask a question now by the time I got the letter I would have forgotten about the question.

Well if I get the line I will send it to my old "No Slack" unit. They can always use it.

Today I ask for R&R in Hawaii in January. Some people said that I will not get it because by that time the whole division will be going home. Only time will tell.

Things have been quiet. We just finish running a medevac request. A medevac is a ~~state~~ helicopter ambulance. Two ARVN soldiers were running a high fever. I think they both had malaria. I take a horse pill each week to prevent malaria myself.
