pass the contents of packages

the few Americans on T Bone.
Everybody liked it. I still
have some hot cocoa mix
from the last package.
No more coal aid now.
The monsoon has arrived.
Today was cold and foggy.
Things are ok. with me.
Nothing new. I just read
all day and kill time.
Only 2 10 days left if I
don't get a drop.

Three more enemy soldiers were killed 3 miles south of T Bone a few days ago. That has been the only combat.

I am still reading a book on Chemistry. I don't know what I would do if I did not have a good book to keep my mind going. I will read At Ease + Imperial Japanese mex.

We have a number of other good books around that I will get to later. There is nothing else to do but listen to the radios (Army radios).

I ate with the Veterans again tonight. That makes about three or four times this week. I have no trouble with chop sticks now. It is interesting but

prefer American food. In fact I would like to say no but I can't. It is part of my job. A hazard of combat you might say. It's not that bad. I will just be glad to get back to hamburgers and milk shakes.

I still have not received any reply from my Christmas gift orders. I should receive a reply soon. This means that the gifts may arrive after Christmas. I don't know for sure. I hope not. When they do arrive please inform me of any customs duty and the condition of the gifts them-

selves. I can't wait to get
here to that stores.
