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Here is another letter. I am not sure what I am going to say. Nothing is new so I don't know what I am going to write about. I am just sitting here with nothing else to do but write, after all it is free.

Well I am up for another Vietnamese party. The main dish tonight is water buffalo.

The party is over now. It was ok, not half as bad as I was afraid of.

We had crab soup to start with followed by a type of Vietnamese enchilada. White tartans made of rice flour filled with beef and mint leaves covered

with hot sauce. The hot sauce was made of the juices of rotting fish. The fish are stacked up and allowed to rot while a small cup catches the sauce. It was ok and not as bad as it sounds. It is a number one dish in Vietnam.

This was followed by water buffalo with a Vietnamese lettuce. Then came the chicken steam. One piece of chicken with carrots and potatoes. We did not have rice this time which is unusual. A banana was served to finish the meal.

The food was fairly good as I said. The water buffalo was easy to cut which made the meal.
