COMMENTS AND DEFINITIONSI. Administration

The elementary school system in Laos is administered at the national level by the Office of Elementary and Adult Education. School administration in the 16 provinces of Laos is the responsibility of 22 Primary School Inspectors. There is currently no school inspector for the province of Phong Saly. It should also be noted that a second school inspector has recently been appointed for the Vientiane district, but this division of the district is not shown in the statistics for the 1967-68 school year.

II. Enrollment

Between the close of the 1966-67 school year and the close of the 1967-68 school year, the total enrollment in public elementary school increased from 156,481 to 166,159, or 6.18 percent. During recent years, the increase in enrollment has been close to 10 per cent each year. The lower rate of increase for 1967-68 was caused mainly by the closing of many schools in Attapeu and Saravane Provinces, because of the military situation in those areas.

Of the total number of pupils in public schools at the end of the 1967-68 school year, 78.8 per cent were in the first three grades and 44.5 per cent were in Grade One. However, the information given under "remarks" on Table No. 5 shows an acceleration in the number of pupils reaching the upper elementary grades.

Table No. 7 presents the number of pupils in each grade in the public schools who were promoted to the next grade at the end of the 1967-68 school year. A little less than half of the pupils are not promoted and must therefore repeat the same grade or drop out of school.

Table No. 8 shows the number of pupils who passed the sixth grade final examination (Certificat d'Etudes Primaires, or CEP) and also gives an indication of the success these pupils had in being admitted to the secondary schools in the country. The table below shows the substantial increase in the number of successful candidates for the CEP over the past 21 years, although it should be noted that the number of public school pupils who passed the CEP examination in 1968 was only 3.5 per cent of the total number of pupils enrolled in public schools.

III. Schools

Although the Ministry reports an increase of 111 public elementary schools since last year (see Table No. 11), it should be noted that the Ministry includes schools that are in operation and schools that are closed, mostly for security reasons, in its figure. The number of schools in operation actually decreased by 83. There were 16 more groupes scolaires, 2 more demi-groupes scolaires, and 27 more primary schools in operation since the previous year, but there was a decline of 127 in the number of CREC schools in operation. 98 of the CREC schools that closed were in Saravane, Wapikhamthong, Savannakhet and Khammouane Provinces.

Definitions of the different types of schools are as follows:

Groupe Scolaire (197 in operation): A six-year elementary school which meets certain requirements (an enrollment of 180 pupils, at least 20 pupils in grade six, at least three surrounding primary schools, etc.). The director of a groupe scolaire is a sub-administrator under the Primary School Inspector with responsibilities for the primary and CREC schools in his area.

Demi-Groupe Scolaire (159 in operation): An elementary school with more than three grades but usually less than six, which has not yet qualified to become a full groupe scolaire.

Primary School (1041 in operation): A village school which usually has the first three grades. At least one teacher in a primary school would be a qualified (Xan Tri) civil service employee.

CREC School (565 in operation - 189 in wats, 376 in villages): A CREC school ("Centre Rural d'Education Communautaire") often has only one grade but sometimes reaches grade three. The teacher in this type of school may be a monk or a village volunteer who receives a small monthly allowance from the ministry.

IV. Teachers

Teachers employed as civil servants have the following grade classifications:

Xan Eck: Class I Civil Servants. 19 school inspectors and other school officials have achieved this grade.

Xan Tho: Class II Civil Servants. The Ministry employs 1065 Xan Tho teachers, who are graduates of the tenth grade or the equivalent, and qualified to teach grades 4-6.

Xan Tri: Class III Civil Servants. The Ministry employs 3103 Xan Tri teachers, who are graduates of the sixth grade with one or two years of teacher training, or the equivalent, and qualified to teach grades 1-3.

The civil service teachers are supplemented by a corps of CREC teachers, who are basically volunteers, and by a group of teachers in some areas who are paid by the military. The Ministry also employs a group of Fundamental Educators whose jobs are usually concerned with adult education and community development. During 1968, 57 Fundamental Educators were transferred from the Ministry of Education to the Commission for Rural Affairs, leaving a total of 65 at the Ministry.
