1. MEMBERSHIP. On 30 Apr 1982 we have 2296 remitted. This is 100 more than we closed out with on 1981. The AUXILIARY had 120 on same date. Last year had 99 same time. 17. See item 29 also. HELEN MORGAN MOORE, wife of Capt BEN MOORE, USN RET, deceased, has joined the CHINA POST 1. She lives at [REDACTED]. Upon receipt of CASH's ltr, referenced in item 29, she phoned. They had quite a conversation. In joining, she sent preliminary picture of BEN soaking his feet in a real homey scene, plus others of home life situations. In joining she wrote, "enclosed is check and additional for Dragon Fund and the POP BUELL Memorial Fund. Also she will help with more items from husband BEN's writings. .. Monthly reports; Pictures, MOORE Naval History, Quotes, etc!" And will honor us with the presentation at a Reunion.

18. PAUL REIHLE, Cmdr SINAI MEMORIAL DIVISION, advises new address for post business will be PAUL REIHLE, E-Systems Inc./MFO [REDACTED]. They are taking the banner with them to the new location at EL GOURA (EITAM).... The SINAI FIELD MISSION, as such was demobilized on 25 April 1982 and is no more. 21. MALCOLM E REED (Aimee, who is Emmy's cousin) visited for first time this area. Live at [redacted] He was USA-2, Amer Air Lines for years, now with Post office there. Is a collector of paperbacks from original series. A massive collection. Dtr GINNY ADLIP, who was officer in USA now lives at [redacted] in the original home built there almost a 100 years ago. This is next door to the County Courthouse. Lotsa original and TV stories about that town which is "Too Tough to Die"

22. BARRY W REED (Tu T) USA-4 SOF 5 Loadmaster/kicker Air America from Sept 1966 to July 1974. The KICKERS hold their RE-UNION along with the rest of us at the Reunions. Last year REED had located all the original photo (head ID type) pictures of all the Kickers from the 1971 era. They worked the Otters, the Caribous, the C-123, the C-46, the C-47, & C-130 acfts. Based in Udorn and Vientiane. He had the pictures of the Udorn groups. Also pictures, same style, all name identified, for the LAO and THAI kickers too. HERALD was in charge of them until about 1972 when JC BOND took his place. BOBBY HERALD was aboard acft when Capt JIM RHYNE got hit and did his share of the work in keeping RHYNE's wounds closed in flight.

HESTER "BOUGHT THE FARM" near Phu Bia in a C-130 with Capt KEVIN COCHRAN. .. E D WEISSENBACK met his DESTINY near Pak Beng a few days after XMAS in 1971.... BARRY REED was almost an ACE in reverse. Was with Capt CAVILL in making his first Air Drop which wiped 2 of 3 parked friendly helicopters.. Later he was strapping in passengers and a T-28 pilot landing verred into them while at the loading ramp...T-28 coming into 20-A long and hot.... so when that C-123 # 576 came out from major mtce 2 H-34's and a T-28 silhouettes were freshly painted over the cargo door.... Losses of the multi engine fixed wing which kickers worked in from about Xmas 1971 to April 1974 were 2 of the x Otters, 3 of x Caribous; 5 of x C-123; 1 of x C-130; one of x C-46; and 0 of x C-47's. And he intimates losses in single engines fixed and rotary winged were much higher.

Anyone thinking the flight crews weren't in hazardous situations simply is not aware of the SOF responsibilities.

Item run in PS to help locate the "lost" man.

Women's liberation movement and entry into job market with the social revolution....."

"The medias relation with government has taken a turn for the worse.. The government has become the enemy.. Every policy initiative, every action must run a gauntlet of criticism... controversial and conflict sought out where ever they can be found... in this centrifuge of criticism and controversy, authority is dissipated.. capacity to govern is weakened.."

"The media have contributed to the disarray in government.. the corollary of increased power is increased responsibility.."

"The media should resist the "media hype", the media pseudo event. ..Janet Cooke's fiction... false reporting.. The media has acquired power "all out of proportion" to its ability or inclination to use it responsibly... Editors must accept more effective right of reply than just letters to the editor or an occasional Op-Ed piece"....

140. The PUBLIC, have thought this way for a long time and must continue to hit them in pocket book with lawsuits... Typical is what happened to the ENQUIRER. Also such a right wing paper like the Liberty Lobby and the SPOTLIGHT..
