COMMENTS AND DEFINITIONS

I. Administration

The elementary school system in Laos is administered at the national level by the Department of Elementary and Adult Education and in the sixteen provinces by twenty-two Primary School Inspectors. There is at present no school inspector for the province of Phong Saly.

II. Enrollment (Tables 1 - 8)

The closing report for school year 1970-71 and school year 1971-72 showed an increase in total enrollment in public elementary schools from 205,989 to 212,711, or 3.26 per cent.

Of the total number of pupils in public schools at the end of the 1971-72 school year, 75.22 per cent were in the first three grades and 39.91 per cent were in grade one.

The information given at the bottom of Table No. 5 shows an increase in the number of pupils reaching the upper elementary grades. One of the project design goals is for two out of five students to be enrolled in grades 4-6 by 1976.

Table No. 7 shows the number of pupils in each grade in the public schools who were promoted to the next grade at the end of the 1971-72 school year. The drop in the number of promotions from the first grade can be attributed to the transfer and assimilation of children, at this level, in other school situations. The reform of the sixth grade final examination resulted in more comprehensive subject matter testing and a decrease in the number of promotions compared to previous years. For other grades the normal retention rate of forty per cent was reduced, particularly in grade five.

Table No. 8 shows the number of pupils who passed the sixth grade final examination (Certificat d'Etudes Primaires, or CEP) and also the number admitted to secondary schools in the country. The table below shows the substantial increase in the number of successful candidates for the CEP over the past years, with the exception of 1971-72, as previously explained.

III. Schools (Table 9 - 12)

According to Tables 9 and 11, there was an increase of 148 public elementary schools since last year. However it should be noted that, in this figure, the Ministry included schools that were closed, mostly for security reasons.

Actually, the number of schools in operation increased by 37 since last year. There were 21 more groupes scolaires, and 13 more demi-groupe-scolaires, as well as a slight increase in primary schools in operation; but there was a decrease of 21 CREC schools operating in villages and wats, as compared to the closing report for school year 1970-71.

Definitions of the different types of schools are as follows:

Groupe Scolaire (273 in operation): A six-year elementary school which meets certain requirements (an enrollment of 180 pupils, at least 20 pupils in grade six, which has operated for one year, at least three surrounding primary schools, etc...). The director of a groupe scolaire is a sub-administrator under the Primary School Inspector with responsibilities for the primary and CREC schools in his area.

Demi-Groupe Scolaire (195 in operation): An elementary school with more than three grades but usually less than six, which has not yet qualified to become a groupe scolaire.

Primary School (978 in operation): A village school which usually has the first three grades. At least one teacher in a primary school should be a qualified (Xan Tri) civil service employee.

CREC School (459 in operation - 77 in wats, 382 in villages): A CREC school ("Centre Rural d'Education Communautaire") often has only one grade but sometimes reaches grade three. The teacher in this type of school may be a monk or a village volunteer, who receives a small monthly allowance from the Government. The Ministry has implemented a special training program to qualify CREC teachers.

IV. Teachers (Tables 13 - 16)

Teacher employed as civil servants have the following grade classifications:

Xan Eck: Class I Civil Servants. 35 school inspectors and other school officials have achieved this grade.

Xan Tho: Class II Civil Servants. The Ministry employs 2149 Xan Tho teachers, who are graduates of the tenth grade or the equivalent and qualified to teach grades 4-6

Xan Tri: Class III Civil Servants. The Ministry employs 3586 Xan Tri teachers, who are graduates of the sixth grade with one or two years of teacher training, or the equivalent, and qualified to teach grades 1-3.

The civil service teachers are supplemented by CREC teachers and by a group of teachers in some areas who are paid by the military.
