I. Administration

The elementary school system in Laos is administered at the national level by the Office of Elementary and Adult Education. School administration in the 16 provinces of Laos is the responsibility of 22 Primary School Inspectors. There is currently no school inspector for the province of Phong Saly.

Table No. 8 shows the number of pupils who passed the sixth grade final examination (Certificat d'Etudes Primaires, or CEP) and also gives an indication of the success these pupils had in being admitted to the secondary schools in the country. The table below shows the substantial increase in the number of successful candidates for the CEP over the past 24 years.

II. Enrollment (Table 1 - 8)

Between the close of the 1968-69 school year and the close of the 1969-70 school year, the total enrollment in public elementary school increased from 174,885 to 183,929 or 5.17 percent.

Of the total number of pupils in public schools at the end of the 1969-70 school year, 76.9 percent were in the first three grades and 41.4 percent were in Grade One. However, the information given under "remarks" on Table No. 5 shows an acceleration in the number of pupils reaching the upper elementary grades.

Table No. 7 presents the number of pupils in each grade in the public schools who were promoted to the next grade at the end of the 1969-70 school year. About 40 per cent of the pupils are not promoted and must therefore repeat the same grade or drop out of school.

III. Schools (Table 7 - 12)

Although the Ministry reports an increase of 158 public elementary schools since last year (see Table "6. 11"), it should be noted that the Ministry includes schools that are in operation and schools that are closed, mostly for security reasons, in its figures. The number of schools in operation actually decreased by 16. There were 17 groupe scolaires, and 65 more CREC schools in operation since the previous year, but there was a decrease of 97 in the number of primary schools and 2 in the number of demi-groupe scolaires in operation.

Definitions of the different types of schools are as follows:

Groupe Scolaire (226 in operation): A six-year elementary school which meets certain requirements (an enrollment of 180 pupils, at least 20 pupils in grade six, at least three surrounding primary schools, etc.). The director of a groupe scolaire is a sub-administrator under the Primary School Inspector with responsibilities for the primary and CREC schools in his areas.

Demi-Groupe Scolaire (164 in operation): An elementary school with more than three grades but usually less than six, which has not yet qualified to become a full groupe scolaire.

Primary School (910 in operation): A village school which usually has the first three grades. At least one teacher in a primary school would be a qualified (Van Tri) civil service employee.

CREC School (593 in operation - 184 in wats, 409 in villages): A CREC school ("Centre Rural d'Education Communautaire") often has only one grade but sometimes reaches grade three. The teacher in this type of school may be a monk or a village volunteer who receives a small monthly allowance from the ministry.

IV. Teachers (Tables 13 - 16)

Teacher employed as civil servants have the following grade classifications:

Van Tck: Class I Civil Servants. 25 school inspectors and other school officials have achieved this grade.

Van Tho: Class II Civil Servants. The Ministry employs 1544 Van Tho teachers, who are graduates of the tenth grade or the equivalent, and qualified to teach grades 4-6.

Van Tri: Class III Civil Servants. The Ministry employs 3227 Van Tri teachers, who are graduates of the sixth grade with one or two years of teacher training, or the equivalent, and qualified to teach grades 1-3.

The civil service teachers are supplemented by a corps of CREC teachers, who are basically volunteers, and by a group of teachers in some areas who are paid by the military.
