

IVS/White Dog Cafe S.E. Asia Trip

International Voluntary Services and the White Dog Cafe announce a January 16 - February 3, 1995 Gourmet and Study Tour to Viet Nam and Thailand with an optional extension to Angkor Wat and Phnom Penh. In Bangkok, the group will meet Burmese refugees and will visit the IVS Empower Center where work on AIDS prevention takes place. While in Bangkok the group will also take canal rides, see the Royal Palace and Thai Dance. In Hanoi, we will see the Water Puppets, the marketplace, museums, meet with the Women's Union and visit the Women's Union/IVS family planning clinic. We will take an overnight train to Hue and see the citadel, the Tu Duc and Ming Mang tombs, visit Thien Mu Pagoda by river boat and spend an evening on the Perfume River listening to Vietnamese Folk Music. In DaNang, we'll visit the Cham Museum, Le Ly Hayslip's Friendship Village, climb Marble Mountain and spend the evening on China beach. In Ho Chi Minh City, we'll go to the marketplace, a handcraft cooperative and drive to My Tho to see more of rural Viet Nam.

The optional tour to Cambodia begins with a January 29 flight to Angkor Wat where we'll spend two full days at the ruins of the ancient Khmer civilization. On Feb. 1, we fly to Phnom Penh where we'll visit the Art Museum and see the IVS/Indradevi Women's Union AIDS prevention project.

The cost of the basic tour is \$3950 and the Angkor Wat/Phnom Penh extension is \$500, or a total of \$4450. The tour cost includes hotel, food, visas, airport taxes and transfers, admission to events and airplane fare from any U.S. city. The tour price does not include personal expenses such as cigarettes, laundry, alcoholic beverages, etc. For further details, contact Don Luce (Tour Leader) at IVS.
