Prime Minister's Decree

THE PRIME MINISTER, PRESIDENT  
OF MINISTERS COUNCIL

Seen Royal Decree No.100 dated April 2, 1952, subject  
reorganization of Ministers Council;

DECRETES

Article 1. Allowances granted by the MoE to CREC teachers,  
bonzes teachers, or secular teachers recruited  
locally are as follows, effective July 1, 1970.

- K 3,000 per month for beginners
- K 3,800 per month for those who have served  
for two years uninterruptedly, attended  
the first pedagogic training, and passed  
the exam.
- K 4,600 per month for those who have served for  
three years uninterruptedly, attended the  
second pedagogic training, and passed  
the exam.
- K 5,400 per month for CEP certificate holders who  
have served for four years uninterruptedly,  
attended the third pedagogic training,  
and passed the exam.
- K 6,000 per month for those who have served for  
five years uninterruptedly, attended the  
fourth training, and passed the exam.

Article 2. CREC teachers who have served for 5 years  
uninterruptedly, got four certificates from  
pedagogic training may present themselves to C.A.P. exam,  
on proposition of PSI.

Article 3. Modalities and Programs for the pedagogic training  
as mentioned above will be defined by a ministerial  
decree.

Article 4. CREC teachers must teach at least five hours a day, and five days a week. They are entitled each to two and a half months paid annual leaves in a year.

Article 5. Bonze-teachers teaching in Rural Community Education Center will receive half of the remunerations set forth in article 1.

Article 6. CREC teachers who attended training but failed twice at the same exam will be deleted from the list, on proposition of PSI.

Article 7. Provisions in the Prime Minister's Decree No. 747/PC dated December 13, 1945 are, and remain rescinded.

Article 8. The Vice-President of Ministers Council; Minister of National Education, Fine-Arts, Sports & Youth; Minister of Finances; Director of Prime Minister Secretariat are responsible, each, of what concerns them, for the execution of this decree.
