ORDER

ARTICLE 1. The Ministerial Decree No. 735/ED dated November 16, 1966 fixing the monthly rate of scholarships and other amounts allocated for students in different schools, is hereby rescinded.

ARTICLE 2. The monthly rate scholarships and other amounts allocated which can be allowed students in different schools affiliated with the Ministry of National Education, Fine Arts and Sports and Youths are fixed as follows effective the school year 1972-73.
