Review of Dry Season Resettlement Program - Xieng Khouang -  
Classrooms

Larry Woodson and I reviewed the Xieng Khouang review of dry season program statistics carefully with figures from PRO and request that you and your staff review the following suggested modifications of the original figures.

A close analysis of the number of carry-over units for FY 73 shows that you will probably have to carry-over 55 permanent rooms. If 80 rooms of the approved DSR classrooms were cancelled as proposed this would only leave a 15 temporary room carry-over, which is probably a little small. We are suggesting that you only cancel about 15 temporary rooms.

Another area is the thirty new rooms proposed for 72/73 Dry Season. This amount of thirty permanent rooms coupled with the proposed 55 permanent carry-over units is probably beyond the areas capability. However, all of these ideas are suggestions only and require local interpretation and follow up.
