Mr. Larry Woodson, CEA/Refugees, gave me some Health Education posters you supplied him and he told me you would be interested in assisting in a review and revision of MoE Hygiene textbooks for elementary grades.

The Department of Primary Education has indicated it will support both of these activities and the posters are currently under review by the RLG. The Education Division has made the following suggestions for implementation:

1. Review available posters and their content for possible use in grades 1-6.
2. Select posters to be used by grade level.
3. Develop a set of mimeographed instructions to go along with each set to insure proper usage. The tendency to use posters as decoration and not as educational tools has to be avoided.
4. Each set of instructions will be cross referenced to existing curriculum guides, course outline, and hygiene textbooks.

The revision of Hygiene textbooks will entail a longer and more complicated process which is outlined below:

1. Planning meetings with PHD/RLG, PHD/USAID, MoE, and USAID/EDU.
2. Assignment of personnel to revise textbooks.
3. Submission of copy to MoE for approval.
4. MoE submits new books to Royal Academy for approval.
5. Printing.
