3. Three participants, one each in mathematics, science, and industrial arts, completed their second year of college study. BMO is arranging for them to study English and mathematics during their annual vacation.
4. Fifteen educators completed a six month course in supervision and field work in teaching. This project, conducted in FY 71 and 72, which combines local in-service training and study and observation in Thailand has prepared one staff member for each district to assist the primary school inspector with supervision of classroom instruction and training courses to improve methods of teaching. These who trained in teaching are assigned to areas to assist with the review of the sixth grade final examination and other teaching procedures.

OTHER

Mr. Sontone Khamsingvath, formerly Director, assumed duties as Deputy Director of Primary Education during the month. Previously the Director of Primary Education had sole responsibility for the administration and supervision of schools; however, the Department is now headed by a deputy director and two other deputies, all of whom are experienced in the administration with the addition of field work in supervision. This arrangement will be of increasing strength and quality in the future.
