SUBJECT : FY73 Urban Self Help Schools

Under the Five Year Plan USAID/AC's and the Education Division have assisted the RIG construct urban school buildings to meet the needs of fast growing urban type population areas. These projects in the past have been developed mainly through the Local Area Coordinators and his staff with technical assistance from Education. There are 80 FY73 rooms under construction currently, and the Ministry of Education has proposed 80 FY73 rooms. Community Education funded 80 rooms for FY73 and probably will be able to do the same for FY74 if the Director approves a similar budgetary level.

CE has included funds in the preliminary draft of the budget for the Spring Review; however, before any approval is requested from Mr. Nam each proposed school location, site, population, and general need in terms of the total area program priorities has to be cleared by the concerned Area Coordinator and his Staff. Community Education Advisors will be contacting you in the very near future to offer assistance in any way needed.

A translation of the RIG proposal is attached for your information and use.
