Project Progress

Curriculum Development

1. In response to MoE request, an activity proposal was prepared and approved to provide a five-day seminar for the science curriculum committee. The committee continued development of objectives, course outlines, and materials for appraisal and adoption at the National Conference of Primary School Inspectors in Phnom Penh. Mr. David Harper, RECSAM Advisor, will assist as consultant at the Conference to complete the curricular project.
2. A safety program with emphasis on pedestrians and operation of two- and four-wheeled vehicles was reviewed with MoE, PSD, and the Safety Education Director of the National Police Department (See September Report). Procedures and materials to implement the program are being planned.
3. A new cover design for students' notebooks was prepared with MoE and submitted to MPC for artwork. The new design emphasizes Lao language and is more useful to students.
