Trip Report - Site 272, December 29, 1972

Mr. Woodson and I visited 272 on December 29, 1972. Trip report follows:

1. Met with Lao Toua, Moua Dang, and Mr. Worley. We covered routine business. Vang Pao and Bountalangsy have asked Ministry of Finance for 30 more teachers. No answer yet.
