## III Noodle Project

The Km-4 Noodle Factory reported a stock of 40 MT on hand at the beginning of the report period. During this period a total of 52 MT of Noodles were produced and 49 MT were distributed to refugees. Stocks on hand at the end of the period totaled 69 MT.

## IV Clothing Project

During August Ban Houei Sai completed 2,000 pieces of refugee clothing and Thakhek cut 12,000 pieces - 8,000 of which are in sewing centers. There are 307,000 yards of assorted cloth on hand.
