990 MT of 2 1/2 Purpose Flour arrived in PVTE Port on 23 May. There were no other arrivals during the month period although an additional 990 MT of Flour departed the States on 20 May.

There are no commodities remaining in TA 1606 to be called forward. However, Food For Peace Office called forward 1,750 MT Bulgur, 400 MT Veg Oil, 1,100 MT Commercial, and 190 MT W&B against our FY 74 TA.

PL-480 loads included in the May Air Drop Operations from VTE totaled 111 MT of Maize and 234 MT of Commercial.

IV. Noodle Production

The MMF Noodle Factory reported a stock of 141 MT on hand at the beginning of the report period. During this period a total of 210 MT of Noodles were produced and 171 MT were distributed to refugees. Stocks on hand at the end of the period totaled 69 MT. Four samples were analyzed in May 1974. The average protein content was 10.1% and the average moisture content was 64.1%.
