There were no new commodity arrivals at BKK Port during this period.

PL-480 foods included in July Air Drop Operations from Vientiane totaled 291 MT of Noodles and 249 MT of Cornmeal.

As is evident from the commodity summary above, all PL-480 commodities are in short supply. At the present rate of consumption, FFP is expecting grain supplies to be exhausted in September. Flour arrivals are expected in August and September, but still no word from AID/W concerning the likelihood of receiving any of the missions grain requests.

III. Noodle Project

The KM-4 Noodle Factory reported a stock of 87 MT on hand at the beginning of the report period. During this period a total of 459 MT of Noodles were produced, and 507 MT were distributed to refugees. Stocks on hand at the end of the period totaled 39 MT.

IV. Clothing Project

During July Ban Houei Sai completed 2,000 pieces of refugee clothing, and Thakhek completed 7,840 pieces.
