SUBJECT: Monthly Report for month of November 1971

Problems

Water again. Solved again.

Progress

Main water pump stopped pumping on the morning of 10 November. This generated an immense amount of energy on several fronts. The garage checked out the gasoline pump, and it was hooked up to the auxiliary system. Dr. Veo visited the EDL, and on Thursday morning they were at work putting up poles to the new well and installing the transformer. The USAID maintenance plumbers cut the pipe from the main well and inserted a tee to connect up the new well. All KM-9 plumbers were busy connecting up the pipe to connect the new well into the system. FWD well drilling pulled the main well pump and found the trouble was a hole in the well casing. This is the third time this casing has failed in the last year. By the evening of the 12th the well was back in operation, about half the pipe had been connected up for the new well. Many thanks are due to Public Works Division.

From 8 November to 10 November Mr. Keur, Mr. Onsy and Mr. Thit Luane went to Pakse to assist in maintenance problems. Separate report of this trip is attached. (*Distributed separately - also Green*)

On November 16 I went on R&R for the rest of the month, but from Mr. Keur I found out that the rest of the pipe for the new well was laid and the new pump on the line for testing by 19 November.
