Problems:

Progress:

1. Visitation to Lashio Training and Bawmukhet KTI's have given meaning to some road. Both schools appear to be ready for the new school year. Most of the information obtained was regarding the physical plant. One major item was that both schools may be connected to city power, relieving USAID support of generators.
2. A meeting with Mr. Simpson led to a consideration of re-organization of vocational parts of Dmyok. More meetings will be held to work out the details. This unexpected development may offer the opportunity to phase down, USAID involvement in budgets and maintenance of Teacher Training schools. When information is available on this development, it will be reported to the division.
3. A major shifting of staff at the four large KTI's and new assignments changes in top level Teacher Training staff will require building new relationships early in the new school year.
