Project : Monthly Report for September, 1970.

Problems:

No significant problems noted during this reporting period.

Progress Reported:

With FIC/TA for training two curriculum specialists in Thailand and for ten teaching counselors locally and in Thailand were submitted to the UN/Regional.

The first session of the curriculum course of the UN/Regional was the second session in 1970 were conducted. A group of the Regional part of the curriculum program was developed in the UN/Regional and is being used as a basis for planning revision of curriculum textbooks.

A summary report on the survey questionnaire, completed by 1,000 of some countries in primary schools, was prepared in the UN/Regional, probably to guide organization of a study program of instruction for elementary school students, as suggested by the UN/Regional. (The Home Economics School, as of this session meeting, in Thailand, will be upgraded from a two- to a four-year institution, to be increasing vocational training opportunities for boys and girls in all provinces.)

Following a proposal to assist the UN/Regional to conduct a study for curriculum study and improvement, plans for further research and development were submitted to the UN/Regional. The study was conducted with specifications and cost estimates were received with the UN/Regional and submitted to the UN/Regional.
