Dear Folks:

I hope the 25th turned out ok. I am sorry that I didn't get this letter in the mail sooner, but have been busy of late. Last Friday, I flew down to Vientiane and returned yesterday. Was there a quite a few people there? I hope that everything turned out ok.

I finally received the Popular Science magazine this week. Please thank Bob and Wilma again for me because I really enjoy reading them. I haven't been able to write very many letters because of the long hours that I am putting in. The day begins at 6:30 in the morning and I don't even have time to eat supper until about 9:30 in the evening. So after supper I usually have a beer and right to bed.

When I was in Vientiane I talked about going down there to work next year. They need three agriculturist there and with recruiting as it is they figure that it will be easier to move me down there and get a generalist for here. Time will tell whether or not I get to go down. I am not sure if I want to or not. There is a new house here in L.P. that I will be renting in two months. It has three bedrooms bath, living room and kitchen with servants quarters behind. It is one of the best houses in Luang Prabang and it is really beautiful. The bathroom is in dark green with green fixtures. The floors in the whole house are a sort of green tile. It has water and electricity. Everybody thinks it is tops.

While I was in Vientiane, I had a chance to play softball. I played with the military group and they wanted me to transfer to Vientiane so that I could play with them. They will be flying to Bangkok, Uborn and a couple of other places to play games. It sounds like a lot of fun which is in favor of going to Vientiane next year. I probably wont go down, if I do, until August.

This week we are holding a conference at school for all of the extension agents. This is the first for Laos. I am writing up the discussions and plan to run them off and give to the students at school.

I can't understand how I looked thin in the picture when I weigh about 180. I think every day that I ought to start on a diet. anyway I feel fine now except for where I got shots in Vientiane. It was time to renew some of them.

I have two more boxes of slides to send but have to show them to several people before I can send them. I also have not had time to finish the newsletter. Everybody probably thinks I have been captured by the P.L. or something.

Well I better close if I am going to get this letter in the mail.
