

PRESIDENTIAL DECREE

The Prime Minister, President of the Council of Ministers

DECREES:

ARTICLE 1: The amounts allocated by the Ministry of National Education to the CREC teachers, monk teachers, or former monk teachers recruited locally are fixed as follows beginning from July 1, 1970.

- 3,000 kips per month for beginners.
- 3,800 kips per month for those who have completed two years of continuous service followed by a successful first training for the improvement of teaching.
- 4,600 kips per month for those who have completed three years of continuous service followed by a successful second training for the improvement of teaching.
- 5,400 kips per month among those who hold the certificates indicating that they have completed primary education courses; and have completed four years of continuous service followed by a successful third training for the improvement of teaching.
- 6,000 kips per month for those who completed five years of continuous service followed by a successful fourth training for the improvement of teaching.

ARTICLE 2: Those responsible for Rural Community Education Centers, who have accomplished five years of continuous service and have obtained the four certificates of teaching training can apply for the four year teachers' Certificate (C.A.P. - Certificat d'Aptitude Pédagogique) upon the proposal of the Primary School Inspector.

ARTICLE 3: The organization and programs of the training for teaching improvement mentioned above will be fixed by a Ministerial Decree.

ARTICLE 4: Those responsible for the Rural Community Education Centers must teach a minimum of five hours a day, and five days a week. Each will have a right to two and a half months vacation with pay each year.

ARTICLE 5: The monk teachers practicing in Rural Community Education Centers will be allowed one-half of the salaries given in Article 1.

ARTICLE 6: Those responsible for the Rural Community Education Centers, who failed two training courses of the same type, will be dismissed from the Contract Services upon the proposal of the Primary School Inspector.

ARTICLE 7: The provisions of Presidential Decree No. 747/PC of December 13, 1965, have been endorsed and abolished.

ARTICLE 8: The Vice President of the Council, Minister of National Education, Fine Arts, Sports and Youth, Minister of Finance, and the Director of the Cabinet of the Council of Ministers are charged, each according to his responsibilities, to carry out the Present Decree.
