Play under the Stableford System is really a form of Bogey Competition except that the players, instead of counting the number of holes up or holes down, score a number of points for each hole. The points scored are:

For hole done in one over bogey (Two over Par)	1 point
For hole done in bogey (One over Par)	2 points
For hole done in one under bogey (Par)	3 points
For hole done in two under bogey (Birdy)	4 points
For hole done in three under bogey (Eagle)	5 points

Nothing is scored for a hole done in more than one over bogey.

Each player receives 7/8th of his current handicap.

Shown below is a sample score card describing the Stableford method of scoring:

As usual in all handicapping, a half-a-stroke or better is counted as a whole stroke, less than half-a-stroke is not counted and the strokes are taken at the allotted holes.

You will note your Tournament Committee has arbitrarily assigned handicap strokes with a maximum of 18.

Play will commence at Hole No. 7 (1) and end at Hole No. 6 (18). This is intended to facilitate final computation of the scores, participation in the lunch, and the award of trophies.

The usual tasty picnic lunch shall be served at Larry Woodson's.
