On 22 July 1971, Liberation Radio in Vietnamese to South Vietnam at 2300 GMT broadcast the full text of the PRG Foreign Ministry's 22 July statement on the signing of the 1954 Geneva Accords.

(Excerpts) The 7-point peace initiative of the PRGRSV set forth on 1 July, which is aimed at solving the South Vietnamese problem on the basis of respecting the basic national rights of the Vietnamese people, has opened an honorable way out of Vietnam for the Nixon administration. As a result, it is warmly acclaimed and unanimously supported by the peace and justice loving governments and peoples worldwide, and by the American people. But the Nixon administration has deliberately tried to avoid answering this initiative and has continued to maintain the illusion of winning a position of strength.

The Nixon administration is also stepping up its cunning diplomatic activities with a view to forcing the South Vietnamese people to adopt a solution advantageous to the U.S. But no cruel trick and no cunning machination of the Nixon administration can shake the iron-like determination of the Vietnamese and South Vietnamese people, nor can it reverse the wheel of history.

The period in which the imperialists ruled the roost and oppressed other peoples has gone forever. Now is the era for people to arise to master their destiny. An era in which a people, though small in population, who adopt a proper line, unite, and are determined to fight, can defeat the enemy for the sake of their independence and freedom. They can defeat any aggressive imperialist, including the imperialist ringleader.
