LPA REPORTS 159TH SESSION OF PARIS TALKS ON VIETNAM

[Text] South Vietnam September 14 LPA--At the 159th plenary session of the Paris conference on Vietnam today, Minister Nguyen Thi Binh, head of the PRGRSV delegation to the conference, pointed out:

"At this conference table, the U.S. side has, on the one hand, opposed our correct and constructive proposals, and on the other hand, clung to its absurd demands aimed at forcing the South Vietnamese people to accept the Nguyen Van Thieu puppet administration, rigged up, fostered, and masterminded by the U.S., to use it as a tool for its war of aggression and neo-colonialist policy in South Vietnam. With its 'four-no policy,' the Nguyen Van Thieu puppet clique is going counter to all the South Vietnamese people's earnest aspirations, namely peace, independence, neutrality, democracy and national concord. It has resorted to all fascist measures to repress and terrorize the patriots and whoever opposes it. That is why it is opposed by all strata of the people and is driven into utter isolation. It is evident that the existence of such an administration relies on the armed forces, dollars, bombs and shells, aircraft and warships of the United States."

Then Minister Nguyen Thi Binh referred to the fact that the RSV Provisional Revolutionary Government represents the legitimate aspirations of all strata of the South Vietnamese people and [is the] symbol of the strength of the whole nation, and is bringing the anti-U.S. fight for national salvation from one victory to another. Moreover, the PRG is recognized as the authentic representative of the South Vietnamese people by the people in both zones of Vietnam, the socialist countries, the great majority of the non-aligned nations, various peace and justice-loving governments and people the world over.

"All the schemes worked out in Washington aimed at denying the role of the PRG of the RSV will certainly fail," the minister stressed. The minister then introduced the September 11, 1972 important statement on the ending of the U.S. war of aggression and restoration of peace in Vietnam by the PRG. She stressed: "If the U.S. Government positively responds to the two requests expounded in the statement, peace will soon be restored. This is in the interests of the Vietnamese people and the American people and that of world peace. On the contrary, if the United States stubbornly clings to its policy of "Vietnamization," prolongs and escalates the war, the Vietnamese people have no alternative but to fight shoulder to shoulder with the Lao and Cambodian peoples till their sacred rights are won."
