DRV FOREIGN MINISTRY SPOKESMAN REJECTS THAI 'SLANDEROUS ALLEGATIONS'

((TEXT)) TODAY, 16 JULY, OUR FOREIGN MINISTRY SPOKESMAN ISSUED A STATEMENT CONDEMNING THE THAI AUTHORITIES FOR THEIR SLANDEROUS ALLEGATIONS. THE STATEMENT POINTED OUT:

RECENTLY, THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF THE THAI FOREIGN MINISTRY AND A NUMBER OF OFFICIALS OF THE THAI ADMINISTRATION HAVE REPEATEDLY RELEASED SLANDEROUS ALLEGATIONS, CHARGING THE DRV WITH THREATENING THE PEACE AND NEUTRALITY OF LAOS AND THE SECURITY OF THAILAND.

IT IS UNIVERSAL KNOWLEDGE THAT THE FUNDAMENTAL CAUSE AND SOLE REASON FOR THE FAILURE TO ESTABLISH A TRUE PEACE IN INDOCHINA IS THE FACT THAT THE UNITED STATES IS UNWILLING TO RELINQUISH ITS POLICY OF INTERVENTION AND AGGRESSION IN THIS AREA. IT IS STUBBORNLY CONTINUING TO INTENSIFY ITS MILITARY INVOLVEMENT IN SOUTH VIETNAM AND IS STRIVING TO HELP THE NGUYEN VAN THIEU ADMINISTRATION CONTINUE THE WAR AND SABOTAGE THE PARIS AGREEMENT ON VIETNAM. IT IS TRYING BY EVERY MEANS TO MAINTAIN THE LON NOL CLIQUE AS A TOOL TO WAGE A WAR OF AGGRESSION AGAINST CAMBODIA. IT IS ALSO PLOTTING TO USE THE RIGHTWING IN LAOS TO IMPLEMENT U.S. NEOCOLONIALISM IN THAT COUNTRY.

THE SLANDEROUS ALLEGATIONS AGAINST THE DRV BY THE THAI AUTHORITIES ARE ONLY AIMED AT CONCEALING THE FACT THAT THEY ARE CONTINUING THEIR POLICY OF SERVING THE U.S. SCHEME OF IMPLEMENTING THE NIXON DOCTRINE IN THIS AREA. THE THAI ADMINISTRATION IS DELIBERATELY SEEKING TO JUSTIFY THE CONTINUATION OF U.S. AND THAI MILITARY INVOLVEMENT AND INTERVENTION IN LAOS IN BRAZEN VIOLATION OF THE 1962 GENEVA AGREEMENT AND THE 1973 VIENTIANE AGREEMENT ON LAOS. IT IS ALSO SEEKING TO COPE WITH THE STRUGGLE MOVEMENT OF THE PEOPLE OF ALL WALKS OF LIFE AND THE STUDENTS IN THAILAND WHO ARE DEMANDING THAT THE UNITED STATES WITHDRAW ALL ITS FORCES AND MILITARY BASES FROM THEIR COUNTRY.

THE SPOKESMAN FOR THE DRV FOREIGN MINISTRY RESOLUTELY REJECTS ALL THE AFOREMENTIONED NONSENSICAL ALLEGATIONS BY THE THAI ADMINISTRATION. 161115 TU/HORCHER 16/1200 TH
