PRGRSV PARIS DELEGATION COMMUNIQUE CITES 4 SEP STATEMENT

LPA From North Vietnam [Clandestine] in English to East Europe and the Far East

[Text] South Vietnam September 7 LPA--Our correspondent in Paris reported, the press office of the delegation of the RSV Provisional Revolutionary Government to the La Celle-Saint-Cloud consultative conference on September 5, 1974 issued a communique introducing the September 4, 1974 statement of a spokesman of the RSV Foreign Ministry exposing the U.S. Admiral Noel Gayler's trip to Saigon and the U.S. training of Saigon pilots as a step to escalate the war in South Vietnam.

As evidence the communique referred to the fact that the United States has feverishly sent up-to-date A-37 and F-5E planes, and is preparing to hand over big P.G. warships to the Saigon administration in a bid to strengthen the Saigon navy and air force. According to Saigon newspapers, the U.S. is extensively sending more munitions and war means to the Saigon army.

The communique stressed: "The above-mentioned acts together with the White House's repeated requests for more aid to the bellicose Nguyen Van Thieu junta only reflect that the Ford administration still intentionally follows former President Nixon's wrong and criminal road in South Vietnam."

In conclusion, the communique recalled the resolute demand of the people and Provisional Revolutionary Government of the RSV that the United States must put a complete end to its military involvement and interference in the internal affairs of South Vietnam. The United States and the Nguyen Van Thieu administration must scrupulously observe and strictly implement all the provisions of the Paris agreement and the June 13, 1973 joint communique.
