1. AFP AND AP FROM PARIS APRIL 3 REPORT ON TELEVISION INTERVIEW OF MADAME NGUYEN THI BINH GIVEN PRIOR TO HER DEPARTURE FOR AFRICA. THESE REPORTS ARE ACCURATE ACCOUNTS OF THE INTERVIEW'S MAIN POINTS.

2. MOST NOTEWORTHY ITEM IN THE INTERVIEW IS MADAME BINH'S COMMENT ON THE ACTIVITIES OF GENERAL NGUYEN CAO KY: "HE IS CLEAR WHEN HE CALLS FOR THE DEPARTURE OF MR. NGUYEN VAN THIEU, BUT CONCERNING THE COMMITTEE OF NATIONAL SALVATION THAT HE INTENDS TO ESTABLISH, HE DOES NOT SPECIFY ITS OBJECTIVES. HE DEFENDS WHAT? HE IS AGAINST WHOM? ON THESE POINTS HIS POSITION DOES NOT SEEM DEFINED." SHE REPEATED THE THEME THAT A GOVERNMENT REPLACING THE THIEU ADMINISTRATION SHOULD FAVOR "PEACE, INDEPENDENCE, DEMOCRACY, AND THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PARIS ACCORD".
