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PRGRSV STATEMENT SUPPORTS PRC 20 AUG STATEMENT ON TWO CHINAS

[Text] On 24 August 1971, the spokesman of the PRGRSV Foreign Ministry issued a statement on China's position in the United Nations Organization. The statement said:

Twenty-two years ago, the Chinese people overthrew the ruling yoke of the U.S.-supported reactionary Chiang Kai-shek clique, set up the Government of the People's Republic of China [PRC], the only legal government representing the Chinese people. China's position in the United Nations Organization belongs to the PRC. There is only one China: it is the PRC. Formosa is an inseparable portion of Chinese territory. The U.S. imperialists have committed an armed aggression against, and occupied China's Taiwan and the Taiwan Strait. The fact that they have supported the Chiang Kai-shek reactionaries and maintained the latter's position in the United Nations Organization in order to deprive the PRC of its legal position, and detach Taiwan from China, is a brazen intervention in the internal affairs of China.

The RSV people and their PRG fully support the just stand and legitimate demands of the Chinese people and the PRC Government, as set forth in the 20 August 1971 statement condemning the Nixon administration's plot of creating two Chinas, or one China and one Taiwan, resolutely rejecting the erroneous argument that the status of Taiwan has not been settled, reasserting PRC sovereignty and demanding that the Chiang Kai-shek clique be kicked out of the United Nations Organization and that all the legitimate rights of the PRC in the United Nations Organization be restored to the PRC.

The RSV people and their PRG are convinced that the fraternal Chinese people's struggle for the recovery of Taiwan and the restoration of all the legitimate rights of the PRC in the United Nations Organization will surely be victorious.
