SUBJ: (C) Security Precautions, Subordinate
"Agencies of Rear Service Staff, B3 Front."

(C) (1 page, typewritten; B-3) Letter, number 35/KH, dated 27 Mar 70, signed by Nguyen Lam, Chief of the Rear Service Staff, B3 ((Front)), forwarded to the commanding officers of all units (this copy addressed to the Montagnard Farm Production Detachment), states that according to information from higher headquarters ((possibly HQ, B3 Front)), K ((possibly Khmer aka Cambodian)) troops may attempt to penetrate our ((VC)) rear areas ((possibly of B3 Front)). Therefore, the office ((possibly of the Rear Service Staff, B3 Front)) directs all units to accomplish the following: (1) All depots and troop units must carefully conceal access roads with appropriate camouflage to prevent them from being discovered by K troops. Those areas which have been discovered or are likely to be discovered ((by Cambodian troops)), should evacuate and disperse ((their personnel and equipment)). Personal belongings and papers should be neatly wrapped, and all personnel should be prepared to move on orders; (2) all depots and bivouac areas, including dispensaries, must increase their guards and patrols to control the enemy situation. Security regulations, especially noise discipline, should be strictly enforced. Hunting or fishing in the area of Ta Bop River ((possibly Stoang Ta Pok, vicinity of YA400620)) or the area of X6/VQ5 ((possibly Depot of B3 Front)) is prohibited. It is unauthorized to fire a weapon aimlessly, because the location of the rear area may be revealed; and (3) inform cadre and combatants of all units to properly observe previous directives issued by headquarters ((possibly of B3 Front)) and the office ((possibly of the Rear Service Staff, B3 Front)). Do not allow any person, document, weapon, piece of property, or depot to be captured ((possibly by the Cambodian troops)). It is strictly forbidden to create conflicts or open fire between two sides ((VC/NVA and Cambodia)).
