(C) Item 1: (1 page, handwritten; B-3) Official letter, dated 22 Apr 70, signed by Vo Văn Tới, Deputy Commanding Officer, J24-X20 ((possibly Security Office, Tây Phước Bình Province Unit, aka Combined Base Area Security Command, Military Staff Department, Headquarters, SVNLA)), addressed to Inter-Unit 89, states that in compliance with an order from higher headquarters, Inter-Unit 89 was to transfer the company of K ((Cambodian)) recruits and its equipment, including weapons and ammunition, and skeleton training cadre, to Skeleton Training Unit KB15. This transfer was intended to enable Inter-Unit 89 to intensify its proselyting activities in villages and hamlets and to organize ((Cambodian)) militia and guerrilla forces. These key missions were to be accomplished on an emergency basis.

The K ((Cambodian)) company, after being trained, would be assigned to the district unit ((unspecified)) in accordance with a resolution adopted during a meeting held at ((Tây Phước Bình)) Province Unit on 10 Apr 70.

(U) Item 2: (2 pages, handwritten, typewritten, and printed) Map, scale 1/100,000, with a legend, covers Snuol District, Kratie Province, Cambodia.

(C) Item 3: (1 page, handwritten and printed; B-3) Assembled UTM map sheets, scale 1/100,000, printed by an unspecified printing house, covers Kratie Province, ((Cambodia)) and a border area near Lóc Ninh, ((Tây Ninh Province)), and Bu Dop, ((Phước Long Province)).

Various blue and red pencil marks are shown along the border area between Snuol District, Kratie Province ((Cambodia)), and the Bu Dop area, ((Viet Nam)).

The document also states that the enemy dropped sound detection devices into Unit Quan Hoc Mon area of operation in K ((Cambodia)). Concurrently, enemy ((FVMAF/RVNAF)) Special Forces elements cooperated with reactionary ((Royal Cambodian Army)) troops to discover friendly troop movements, base camps, and logistical installations.

The document also instructs subordinate elements of Unit Quan Hoc Mon to increase their vigilance against enemy ((FVMAF/RVNAF)) psywar activities.
