CONFERENCE SPEAKER STRESSES INDUSTRY-AGRICULTURE INTERRELATION

[Article: "Comrade To Huu Speaks to Conference of District Party Schools"]

[Text] Recently, the Department of Propaganda and Training of the Central Committee organized a conference to review 1976 work and discuss 1977 guidelines and tasks of the party schools of districts and cities of the northern provinces.

After evaluating achievements scored in 1976, the conference drew a number of lessons and experiences regarding leadership and guidance of party committee echelons and propaganda and training departments of all levels in selecting students, improving the quality of instruction and studies, organizing for management and training of the instructors' ranks, managing studies and building the material bases of district party schools.

Regarding 1977 guidelines and tasks, the district and city party schools will endeavor to struggle for accomplishment of two tasks: organizing studies of the resolution of the Fourth Party Congress and completing the organization of studies of the curriculum of basic reasoning for prescribed objectives, at the same time testing the curriculum of primary-level reasoning.

After affirming the achievements scored and those remaining areas of the district and city party schools, comrade Dao Duy Tung, alternate member of the Party Central Committee and deputy chief of the Department of Propaganda and Training of the Central Committee, mentioned a number of problems and requirements that needed to be researched to improve the themes studied and methods of studying them, with the purpose of improving the quality of instruction and studies in party schools at district level and contributing actively to changing the revolutionary movement in the local areas.

Comrade To Huu, alternate member of the Political Bureau and chief of the Department of Propaganda and Training of the Central Committee, spoke to the conference. He analyzed a number of problems in the general policy, the policy of building a socialist economy in our country, the building of district echelons to become economic units combining agriculture and industry and the responsibility of district party schools.

Regarding the relationship between industry and agriculture in the new phase in our country, he said it meant combining to build industry and agriculture into a modern industrial-agricultural structure, and industry and agriculture combining closely with each other in a unified economy. This is a problem of a regulatory nature in the process of moving from small production to big socialist production. To have a modern industrial-agricultural structure, it is absolutely necessary to carry out socialist industrialization.

Regarding the importance of the district, he said: the district is where industry is combined with agriculture; production with circulation and distribution; economy with national defense; state-operated economy with collective economy... This is the meeting point of economic and social relationship; a territory of a decisive nature for successfully carrying out the three revolutions; and the place where the working people's right to collective ownership and the new regime's unified strength are fully manifested. Comrade To Huu also elucidated that the structure and requirement for expansion of the economic and cultural sectors in the district's territory was to quickly turn every district into a territory with an agricultural-industrial structure, moving on to build a beautiful life in the district's territory.

After pointing out a number of weaknesses in reasoning and political education, comrade To Huu reminded the conference of the need to pay utmost attention to binding reasoning with practice and living what one learns, and the necessity to continue research to help the party committee echelon give good elementary and advanced training to the ranks of cadres at the basic echelon, that they may have both good ability and quality to contribute to arousing an enthusiastic revolutionary movement, effectively fulfilling political tasks in their local areas.
